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59.2 **Proposed Road Crossing** – Following on from the report that was presented at the Annual Meeting by the Highways Authority, it was agreed that the concept of a light controlled crossing is not to be vigorously pursued and other measures for slowing traffic through the village are to be considered. The idea of moving the bus stop to the bay on Blandford Hill could help with crossing problems, additional signing on the approaches to the village and other traffic engineering could ease the speeding traffic. A meeting is to be arranged with Steve Howard of Highways to consider what can be done.
